PHILIPPINE VISA

THIS PORTION IS FOR USE OF PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ONLY:

TEMPORARY VISITOR'S VISA (FOR BUSINESS OR PLEASURE)

A. VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO THE PHILIPPINES

- 1. Original passport with validity period of six (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines. Effective 01 October 2016, Non-Machine Readable Passport will no longer be accepted.
- Application for visa FA-FORM NO. 2-A (REVERSE SIDE) duly accomplished and submitted by the applicant in person. An applicant who cannot apply in person may apply by mail provided his/her duly accomplished application is NOTARIZED. Applicant who cannot personally pickup his/her document(s) should submit a selfaddressed prepaid and registered return envelope of a courier service of applicant's choice.
- 3. One (1) 4.5 cm x 3.5 cm photo of the applicant signed at the bottom front taken within the last 6 months from the date of application.
- 4. Original roundtrip airline ticket or travel itinerary plus a photocopy.
- 5. Proof of means of financial income or support i.e. updated bank statement, employment certificate, payroll slip, proof of pension, etc. indicating the name of the applicant.
- 6. Visa fees (non-refundable): For non-visa required nationals who wish to stay in the Philippines for more than 30 days, C\$43.50-single entry valid to be used within 3 months; C\$87.00-multiple entry valid to be used within 6 months; C\$130.50-multiple entry valid to be used within 1 year. For visa-required nationals, C\$ 58.00-single entry valid to be used within 3 months.

Please note that the validity period of the visa is NOT the period of stay in the country. The authorized maximum period of stay in the Philippines - for holders of temporary visitor's visa - is fifty-nine (59) days per entry into the country. If the applicant wishes to stay beyond 59 days, he/she must apply for VISA EXTENSION at the Bureau of Immigration (BI) in Manila, or the Immigration Office nearest to the place where the applicant is temporarily residing. For more information, please visit BI's website, www.immigration.gov.ph.

- 7. Non-Canadian passport holders need to submit a photocopy of proof of **PERMANENT RESIDENCY** in Canada i.e. permanent resident card, work permit card, etc.
- 8. Other documents that may be required by the Consular Officer.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Fees and processing time may vary for non-Canadian passport holders

- B. <u>TEMPORARY VISITOR FOR BUSINESS</u> (Aliens attending international conferences or conventions in the Philippines, business meetings or bona fide businessman)
 - 1. Requirements 1 to 7 identified under item A above.
 - 2. A letter of certification identifying the applicant as bona fide businessman or letter of invitation to an international convention or business meetings and the means of financial support of the applicant during his/her stay in the Philippines. The letter must state the purpose of the trip.
- C. <u>MINORS BELOW 15 YEARS OF AGE traveling to the Philippines not accompanied by a parent or not</u> <u>joining a parent in the Philippines</u> need a Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG) from the Commissioner of Immigration in the Philippines. The following documents shall be submitted to the Philippine Bureau of Immigration at the port of entry:
 - 1. Affidavits of Request and Consent and Guaranty by both parents or legally appointed guardian of the child naming therein the person who will be accompanying the child to the Philippines and with whom the child will reside in the country.
 - 2. Original birth certificate of the child.
 - 3. Clear photocopy of the data page of the child's passport and guardian's passport.

WEG fee must be paid directly at the Bureau of Immigration upon arrival of the minor children at the port of entry.

Minors accompanied by one parent only should submit notarized letter of consent from the other parent or a court order stating that only one parent has legal custody of the minor.

Minors joining his/her parent(s) in the Philippines should show documentary proof that his/her parent(s) is/are in the Philippines.

D. PERSONS exempt from visa requirements:

Returning "*balikbayans* or former Filipinos" may enter the Philippines without a visa and stay for a period of one (1) year provided they have a passport valid for 6 months beyond intended stay in the Philippines, a roundtrip ticket and can present proof of former Philippine citizenship (e.g. old passport, birth certificate). Foreign spouses and children who are traveling with the *balikbayan* are included in the privilege. Nationals of countries which have diplomatic relations with the Philippines are generally allowed entry into the country without a visa for a stay of 30 days or less, provided the nature of trip is for tourism, they are holders of round trip or outbound airline ticket and their passports are valid for six (6) months beyond the intended stay in the Philippines. U.S. and Canadian passport holders are covered by this rule. (For other nationalities, please check with the Philippine Consulate General).

NOTE: All fees are payable only in cash or money order/bank draft/cashier's check made payable to the Philippine Consulate General. **Do not send cash in the mail.** Fees and processing time may vary for non-Canadian passport holders. For Chinese nationals, please print pages 1 and 2 of non-immigrant visa application form, back to back.
