### WHEN TO REGISTER AS OVERSEAS VOTER (OV) FOR THE UPCOMING 2028 PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ELECTIONS?

- 01 December 2025 - 30 September 2027

### WHO IS QUALIFIED TO REGISTER AS OV?

- A citizen of the Philippines, not otherwise disqualified by law
- At least 18 years old on or before 08 May 2028 (Election Day)
- Former Filipino who reacquired Philippine citizenship by virtue of RA 9225 or Citizenship Retention & Re-acquisition Act of 2003 (Dual Citizenship Act)
- Filipino permanent residents,
- Filipino who will be residing, working, or studying in Canada by 08 May 2028

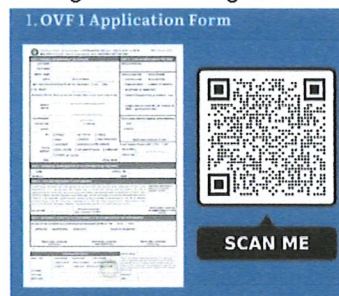
### WHERE TO REGISTER IN PERSON OR VERIFY STATUS OF YOUR PREVIOUS OV REGISTRATION?

- At local Consular Outreach Mission in your locality (see [www.vancouverpcg.org](http://www.vancouverpcg.org) for schedule)

Note: Failure to vote in the last two (2) consecutive Philippine National Elections will result to deactivation and removal from the National Registry of Overseas Voters (NROV).

### PLEASE PREPARE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION:

1. Accomplish the online iRehistro through the following QR Code:



2. Print out the accomplished form with QR code.
3. Bring the accomplished form with QR code to the Consulate or during the Consular Outreach together with your valid passport or
  - In the absence of a valid passport, a Certification of the Consulate.
  - For dual citizens: Original or Certified True Copy of the Order of Approval of Filipino citizenship or Identification Certificate.
  - For seafarers: Seafarer's Identification Record Book (Seafarer's Book).
