The following NEW Philippine Airlines' Travel Procedures for Manila will take effect on July 27, 2020. PAL passengers are asked to Pre-Register 3 days prior to their departure for Manila thru the PAL website. Procedures are shown below:

Complete the Electronic Health Locator Form and Arrival Card through the Philippine Bureau of Immigration portal or by scanning the QR code below:



AT THE TERMINAL

- Undergo thermal screening upon deplaning
- Accomplish the additional required forms 3
- For Overseas Filipino Workers: proceed to the verification booth 5 and undergo the free COVID-19 RT-PCR Test
- Proceed to Immigration 6

- Proceed to your designated waiting area 2
- Undergo briefing conducted by the Philippine Coast Guard
- For Returning Overseas Filipinos: Proceed to the verification booth, and pay and undergo the COVID-19 RT-PCR Test

AT THE HOTEL

Check-in and wait for your test results

1 For Overseas Filipino Workers: may take up to 3-5 days

For Returning Overseas Filipinos: may take up to 2 days

Test results will be sent via the e-mail address you provided during registration

NEGATIVE RESULT (2)

Present your result and certificate to the assigned quarantine personnel at the hotel for clearance

POSITIVE RESULT

You will be endorsed by the BOQ to a hospital for further medical management

Obtain your BOQ medical certificate 3 via the DOH-BOQ certificate page.



You may ask your relatives to pick you up or arrange your own transportation going home



Passengers without access to any electronic device MUST pre-register but need to write down their UNIQUE REFERENCE CODE and proceed to assistance desk on arrival.

We encourage all PAL passengers to follow the above procedures, register in advance, pre book their hotels and transfer as necessary to avoid any inconvenience and experience faster processing upon arrival in Manila.
