RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING A RESTAURANT/FOOD VENDOR/CATERER TO PROVIDE REFRESHMENTS DURING THE 128TH PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY FILM SCREENING AND RECEPTION ON 11 JUNE 2026

WHEREAS, in commemoration of the 128th Philippine Independence Day, the Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver ("Consulate") intends to host a reception and film showing on 11 June 2026;

WHEREAS, the hosting of a reception and film showing is an opportunity to strengthen ties between the Consulate and various stakeholders, including diplomatic corps, Filipino community organizations, local partners and to promote/showcase Philippine culture, history, Filipino talent and creativity through film and cultural presentation;

WHEREAS, for the conduct of said event, the Consulate needs to procure refreshments with the following requirements:

- 1. Menu Requirements:** Restaurant/ Food vendor/Caterers must provide the following curated menu:
 - Chicken Adobo Empanada;
 - Miki Sotanghon (no pork); and
 - Fried Vegetable Rolls
- 2. Service Requirement**
 - Timely and Seamless Delivery
 - Food warmers with fuel gel only
 - At least two (2) servers during the reception
 - Provision of food labels with ingredients
 - Responsible for set-up and egress
- 3. Serving Size**
 - Restaurant/ Food Vendor must prepare menu for 160 guests

WHEREAS, in this procurement, the Consulate adopts Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Resolution No. 28-2017 dated 31 July 2017, which sets forth the Guidelines for the Procurement of Goods, Services, Infrastructure Projects, and Consulting Services to be Procured and Performed Abroad, together with the pertinent provisions of Section 28 (Limited Source Bidding) and Section 34 (Small Value Procurement) of Rule IV of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 12009;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned Resolution, rules, and modes of procurement, the Consulate caused the posting of the Request for Quotations on its website and in a conspicuous area within the office premises, and likewise sent the same via email to restaurants/food vendors/caterers within Metro Vancouver;

WHEREAS, through its Cultural Section, the Consulate sent Requests for Quotation to the following Filipino restaurants/vendors/caterers in Metro Vancouver known to provide, or capable of providing, the required Filipino dishes: (1) Goldilocks Bakeshop; (2) Dine Kanadiyan; (3) Halina Restaurant; (4) Kulinarya Restaurant; and (5) Pinpin Restaurant;


WHEREAS, among the restaurants/vendors contacted, **only Goldilocks Bakeshop submitted a quotation** and expressed willingness to provide the required refreshments for the Consulate's official event;

NOW THEREFORE, this Committee unanimously resolves, as it is hereby resolved, to recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE) of the Consulate, **Goldilocks Bakeshop** as the restaurant/food vendor/caterer that will provide the above-stated refreshments during the Consulate's Film Screening and Reception in commemoration of the 128th Philippine Independence Day on 11 June 2026, in the amount of **One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Two Canadian Dollars and Fifty Cents (CAD 1,832.50)**, inclusive of taxes and other charges, subject to the foregoing requirements and compliance by the end-user with existing auditing rules and regulations.
