RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING PROCUREMENT OF FRENCH LANGUAGE TRAINING COURSE FOR CONSUL GENERAL GINA A. JAMORALIN AND THE AWARDING OF THE CONTRACT TO ALLIANCE FRANCAISE VANCOUVER

WHEREAS, the Consulate General of the Philippines in Vancouver (“Consulate”) intends to avail of the Department’s one-time grant of Foreign Language Training Course for its personnel in 2026;

WHEREAS, the Consulate selected French as the foreign language to be studied being its one of the two official languages of Canada;

WHEREAS, French Language Course is essential in order to strengthen the Consulate’s effectiveness and responsiveness in pursuing its mandate and deliverables in Canada;

WHEREAS, this Foreign Language Training Course has an Approved Budget Contract of Canadian Dollars 2,300.00 included in its PPMP for 2026;

WHEREAS, the DFA’s HRMO in its circular CIR-199-HRMO-2026 issued a one-time blanket authority for all Foreign Service Posts to avail of foreign language training for their personnel to enhance their effectiveness and responsiveness in fulfilling mandates and deliverables in their respective Posts;

WHEREAS, on 20 February 2026, the DFA’s HRMO approved in fax VA-32-HRMO-2026, Post’s request to avail of foreign language training for Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin for Level 2 (A2) French language training;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) Resolution No. 28-2017 dated 31 July 2017, prescribed the rules and procedures to be followed by government entities in the procurement of goods and services, infrastructure projects, and consulting services to be purchased and performed abroad;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 7.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR, and Annex A(3)(a) of GPPB Resolution No. 28-2017, personnel training (French language training course) is included in the Consulate’s Annual Procurement Plan for the Fiscal Year 2026, including approved changes thereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Item 3(b) of GPPB Resolution No. 28-2017, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) caused the posting on its website and in a conspicuous place in the Consulate and sent through email, the Request for Quotations for French Language Training Course with a set criterion for the successful conduct of this training course;

WHEREAS, the BAC received the following quotations:







This refers to HRMO's CIR-199-HRMO-2026 regarding the authority for Posts to avail of foreign language training for personnel in CY 2026. Post proposes French language training for Consul General Gina A. Jamoralin to enhance the Post's diplomatic and cultural engagements in a bilingual host country.

Following an internal assessment, Post informs HRMO that only the Consul General will be availing of the program. It is further clarified that while some personnel previously undertook Level 1 French at Berlitz, none has expressed interest in continuing training, nor has any other staff member indicated an interest in commencing a beginner-level course at this time.

The selection of **Level 2 (A2)** for the Consul General is a logical progression following her successful completion of the **Level 1 French class** administered by Berlitz for Consulate staff from **20 May to 20 July 2025**. Post identified two reputable institutions in Vancouver that offer formal certification aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). To ensure a transparent and comparable assessment of Level 2 (A2) proficiency, the following options were reviewed:

Option 1	Berlitz Academy (Group) - Level 2	Mon/Wed or Tue/Thu (18:30–20:00)	\$1,260.00
Option 2	Alliance Française (Group) - Level 2 - Parts 2, 3 and 4	Mon/Wed, Tue/Thu, or Wed/Fri (09:30, 13:30, or 18:15)	\$1,380.00
Option 3	Berlitz Academy (Private) - Level 2	Customizable / Hybrid (Mon–Sat, 07:00–21:00)	\$3,000.00

All lessons are expected to begin in March 2026. Post has likewise included the above fees in its revised PPMP.

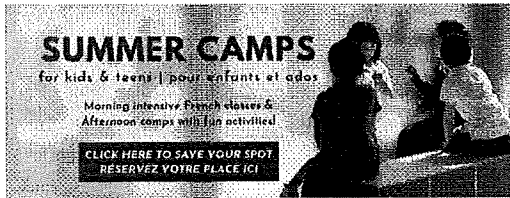

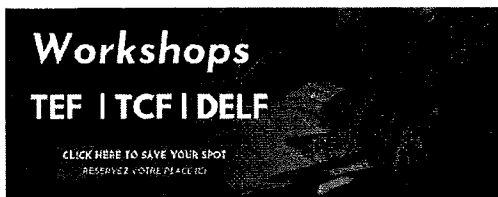

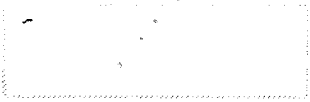

Due to the modular nature of Berlitz's lesson/level structure, theoretically a student can join a group at any point in the progress of a level without having done the previous lessons and then instead take those missing ones at another time. In the case of the Consul General, however, who has already started the level through an in-person format this would not be ideal and especially because then fitting in those missing lessons in the future may be difficult to achieve logistically with delays. If the Consulate

General did not wish to join either of these two groups then we would have to put her on a waiting list until another group commences, which should be as an estimate relatively soon although an exact timing for when would not really be possible to provide.

Additionally, all group lessons are on a fixed schedule without the option to reschedule at the same progress point if a day must be missed. Meaning that those lessons would also have to be caught up on at another time through separate scheduling. Another important note is that the Consul General would be placed into the group with 3 random strangers which may not be a very comfortable situation for her.

For these reasons I would definitely instead recommend private 1 on 1 lessons instead.

Private 1 on 1 Programs (Online, in-person, or hybrid) : Berlitz's private programs are *completely customizable built around the personal schedule of each student*. We would have the Consul General provide a preferred schedule request which we would then match with the availability of our instructor team. Lessons could potentially in this way be provided any time within our teaching schedule that consists of **Monday to Saturday 7:00am to 9:00pm** wide range.

The main benefits of private 1 on 1 programs are that the student receives 100% attention from the instructor, has a minimum of 2 lessons per day but no maximum allowing for faster more efficient progress, and their customizable flexible nature allows for ease of rescheduling.

For both the above pricing options I have selected our lowest price point in each category rather than following our standard tiered scale as we highly value our continuing work with the Consulate along with the greatly positive experience we've had with your team. With the cost difference between the two not being very significant I would again suggest this as further reason to proceed with a far more efficient, flexible, and faster Private 1 on 1 program.

Noting, however, that these groups will only commence when or if they get to at least 3 participating students. As well, their schedules are completely fixed which means any missed classes would have to be rescheduled entirely separately as there is no chance for catching up with the same group. There will be more groups starting in the coming weeks as well if these do not work for the Consul General.

I would feel it very safe to assume that the Consul General has a full and quite busy schedule with last minute changes often occurring without much or any warning. For that reason, I again strongly recommend a private 1 on 1 program for its much greater degree of flexibility and customization.

Once she has had some time to consider, let me know what the final decision will be?
