The Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver invites interested service providers to submit quotations for **carpet and wood floor cleaning services** at the Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver, B.C., to maintain a clean and healthy working environment for its clients and employees.

The technical specifications and requirements for the service are as follows:

1. Professional cleaning services to remove surface stains and thoroughly clean the carpets and wood floors;
2. Use of professional, eco-friendly, and non-toxic products to sanitize the carpets, eliminate odors, bacteria, and allergens, and contribute to a fresh and pleasant environment at the Consulate;
3. Use of professional, wood-safe solutions for polishing hardwood/laminated floors;
4. Provision of other necessary products and processes required for the overall cleaning of both types of flooring; and
5. Cleaning must be completed within one (1) day, preferably on a weekend.

Submission Guidelines

1. Quotations must be submitted **on or before 19 August 2026, at 5:00 PM**, via email at vancouver.pcg@dfa.gov.ph or delivered to the Consulate General premises at **999 Canada Place, Suite 660, Vancouver, B.C.**
2. Receipt of at least one (1) quotation by the deadline shall be sufficient for the Consulate to proceed with the evaluation.
3. Price quotations shall be denominated in **Canadian Dollars (CAD)** and must be inclusive of all applicable local taxes and fees.
